Bill Ladoucer and his brothers had an interesting experience at the Sheenboro dances

“And they said there was quite a number of boys [in the Ladoucer family] and they would go to Sheenboro to dances and they only had one suit. And each one would go in, put the suit on, go in, dance for a time, come back out, and the second guy would put the suit on, go in... And the only thing that you noticed different was, some were shorter than others so the suit had to be... the legs had to be rolled up in order for the ... [laughter] But, I guess it didn't do them any good because none of them ever married Sheen girls, so I guess the suit never was... never was [laughter]. Oh my god, you'd better stop that Liz, or this is gonna get funny [laughter].”
