

## JUNIOR CHOIR

This program is for students aged 9 and up. No previous training is required. If you already play piano and would like to learn another instrument, this is the course for you! As well as participating in the Junior Choir and Orff sessions, students will break into smaller groups and receive daily instruction in one of the following instruments: flute, oboe, clarinet, bassoon, cello or recorder. They will also participate in massed choir, musical arts and recreation with the rest of the camp.

Please indicate your choice of instrument on the registration form. Enrolment in beginner cello will be limited to eight students, on a first-come first-served basis. Instrument rental for woodwinds and cello is included in the course fee. Recorder students must provide their own soprano recorder or purchase one from Summermusic for \$15. All students must provide their own music stand.

## ORCHESTRAL STRINGS

This program is for violin, viola, cello and double bass players with a minimum of two years playing experience, ages 9 to 18. Advanced students are encouraged to attend. Here's your chance to play music with other young musicians! String students will play in a string ensemble and will be joined by the winds and brass for orchestra. They will also participate in massed choir, musical arts and recreation with the rest of the camp. All students must provide their own instrument and music stand.

## WOODWINDS AND BRASS

For students of brass and woodwind instruments, ages 9 to 18. A minimum of two years playing experience is expected; however, students who have recently completed the grade nine high school music course are welcome. Advanced students are encouraged to attend. Recorder players above grade 2 RCM level may join this program. Wind and brass players will play in wind ensemble and will join the strings for orchestra. They will also participate in massed choir, musical arts and recreation with the rest of the camp. All students must provide their own instrument and music stand.

Ms. Hawley is a passionate advocate for music education and has presented numerous music workshops for teachers. She is a teacher with the Ottawa Carleton District School Board, the Artistic Director of the Ottawa Children's Choir, conductor of the Chamber Choir and director of the Cantiamo Girls Choir of Ottawa which she founded in 2003.

Peter Morris studied music education and viola performance at the U. of Ottawa. Peter teaches strings and voice privately in Deep River and Pembroke, and is music director of the Deep River Symphony and the Choral Group. He has conducted the Valley Festival Orchestra and the Kincardine Music Festival Chamber Orchestra as well as working as the music director of many musical theatre productions. Peter is committed to music education and volunteers his time as choir director and music educator at Morrison Public School.

Susan Morris is principal oboist of the Ottawa Symphony Orchestra and is the Senior Chamber Winds coach for the Ottawa Youth Orchestra Academy. She is a dedicated private music teacher, is in demand as a coach for workshops and clinics. Susan is director of Summermusic and for several years was an instructor for the OYOAs summer camp. From 1992 to 2002 she was a member of the chamber music faculty at the Kincardine Summer Music Festival.

Marion Arthur is a Suzuki cello instructor, a Kindermusic teacher and a singer-songwriter performing in both classical and alternative music genres. After several years based in Toronto and Ottawa, Marion is moving back to her home town of Deep River. Marion will be appearing as cello soloist with the Valley Festival Orchestra this summer. 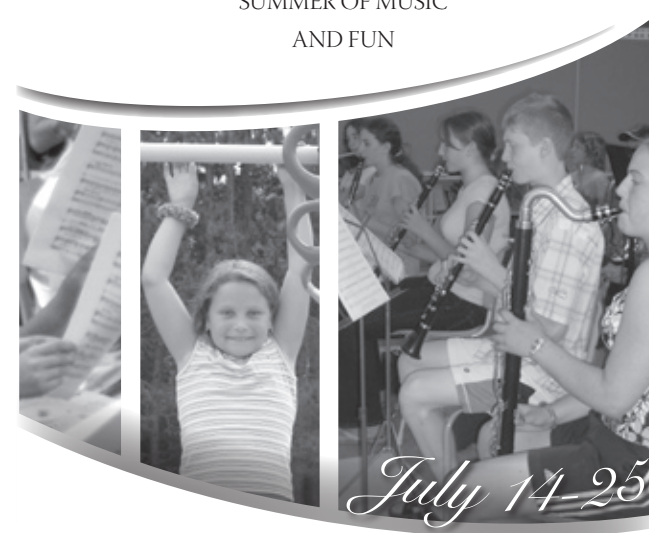
